Dear General Secretary,

The Commonwealth Games Federation has sanctioned the second Mountain and Ultra distance Running Commonwealth Championship which will take place in North Wales from 23rd to 25th September 2011.

On behalf of the Commonwealth Championship Executive Committee, I invite your National Athletic body or Association or Territory to enter teams – or individuals – into these Championships.

I would appreciate you passing on this invitation to the person within your National Athletic body or Territory or Ultra or Mountain Running National body within your country to ensure these bodies have the opportunity to compete in these Championships.

It would help our forward planning by giving an early indication of your intention to enter teams or individuals into these Championships. I would appreciate a response by later than 6th August 2011.

We are fulfilling the Commonwealth Games Federation criteria as shown below.

1. The relevant international Federations have sanctioned the event.
2. The event is open to all athletic National bodies or Associations or Territories within the Commonwealth and is not open to countries outside the Commonwealth
3. Adequate arrangements are in place for the organization of the event.
4. Up to £100,000 is being offered to provide financial support towards travel cost.
5. Accommodation half board is being offered up to 175 athletes and management
6. A suitable range of events is being provided as listed below

(1) Friday 23rd September 2011 - 24 Hour road race Men /Women

(2) Saturday 24th September 2011 – Mountain Up and down Men 12kms, Women 8kms

(3) Sunday 25th September 2011 - Trail Race 55kms Men / Women



7. The events are listed under the World governing bodies approved sports which are the WMRA and IAU under the patronage of the IAAF.
8. Competition is provided equitably with three events for Men and three events for Women
9. Each Commonwealth country can enter Five Men and Five Women for each event.
10. There will be a minimum level of approved doping control standards in place
11. There is no discrimination against any country or person on the grounds of race, colour, gender, religion or politics

We will be able to finalize the size of grant being offered to each Commonwealth Country after 7th August 2011.
