



IAU 50 km World Trophy 2010

GALWAY (IRL)

August 29th 2010



Regulation:

- ⇒ the **IAU 50 km World Trophy Final** will take place in **GALWAY (IRL)**.
- ⇒ date: **August 29th 2010**.
- ⇒ who can participate?
 - all runners officially affiliated to their National Athletics Federation.
 - no restriction of the number of athletes.
- ⇒ the winner of the final race (M and W) will also be the winner of the IAU 50 km World Trophy 2010.

- ⇒ **TRAVEL GRANTS**
 - **only for a maximum of 40 runners** who took part in at least one of the **SELECTION RACES**.
 - If they won the race in at least 3h20' (M) or 3h50' (W).
 - If they belong to the best "losing times" and still ran the qualification time: 3h20' (M) or 3h50' (W).
 - Only when the total of 40 athletes to be invited isn't reached, the IAU can decide to invite other athletes who ran this year a remarkable performance in another IAU Labelled race.

 - the allocation of the travel grants will be done in the same way as for the other MIAUC's. (see : <http://www.iau.org.tw/upload/download/1132001302.pdf>).
 - T-A athletes (A-athletes for the IAU 50 km World Trophy):
 - winners in the Qualifying Time (3h20-M or 3h50-W),
 - additional runners who ran at least,
 - 3h05' (M) or 3h35' (W)
 - T-B athletes:
 - runners who ran at least,
 - 3h10' (M) or 3h40' (W)
 - T-C athletes:
 - runners who ran at least,
 - 3h15' (M) or 3h45' (W)
 - T-D athletes:
 - runners who ran at least,
 - 3h20' (M) or 3h50' (W)
 - the definition of the travel zones remains the same as for the other MIAUC's:
 - zone 1 (Z1): more than 9 hours flying time,
 - zone 2 (Z2): between 4 hours and maximum 9 hours flying time,
 - zone 3 (Z3): maximum 4 hours flying time.

(flying time= between capital of the athlete and the nearest airport to Galway)



⇒ ACCOMMODATION



- **FREE accommodation** (on full board base), **only for a maximum of 40 runners** who took part in one of the SELECTION RACES.
 - If they won the race in at least 3h20' (M) or 3h50 (W).
 - If they belong to the best "losing times" and still ran the qualification time: 3h20' (M) or 3h50' (W).
 - Only when the total of 40 athletes to be invited isn't reached, the IAU can decide to invite other athletes who ran this year a remarkable performance in another IAU Labelled race.
- 3 nights for Z3 athletes, 4 nights for Z2 athletes and 5 nights for Z1 athletes.
- a budget-friendly accommodation offer will be available for non invited athletes and non competitive persons who want to accompany the athletes

⇒ SELECTION RACES

- ONLY **IAU LABELLED RACES** can serve as **SELECTION-RACE**
- maximum 20 selection races (selected by the IAU)
- will pay **100€ as participating-fee**, at least 5 weeks prior to their race, all possible related bank or transaction costs are at the expense of the organisers.
 - will get free advertisement space on the IAU website for at least 5 weeks.
 - will get "silver-label"-space in the new "IAU RESULTS BOOK"
