



How To Claim An Australian Ultra-Running Record

Here are the details on how to claim any Australian National Ultra Running Record:

- **Open or Age Group (Categories are Under-20 and then 20 to 24, 25 to 29, 30 to 34 etc.)**
- **Road or Track**
- **Female or Male**

1. The events both Male and Female that records can be set in:

2. You should be aware of the current records. The current official version is always kept at <http://www.aura.asn.au> They do change so please check before your event.
3. If you believe you are likely to break a record, please let the Race Director know in advance. You should show them the claim forms beforehand so that they know and understand the requirements to make sure that it is measured & timed correctly **before the event**. If you run the event and cannot substantiate or prove that the course is accurate then it may not be possible to award a record.
4. To claim a record you need to complete a copy of the following form and sent it to the records administrator below with **all** the information requested.
5. After being assessed, you will be notified as to whether the claim has been accepted or not. The onus is on the competitor to submit these claims with all facts and the necessary data.
6. The official records (website) will be updated.
7. Certificates will be issued to participants who break records.
